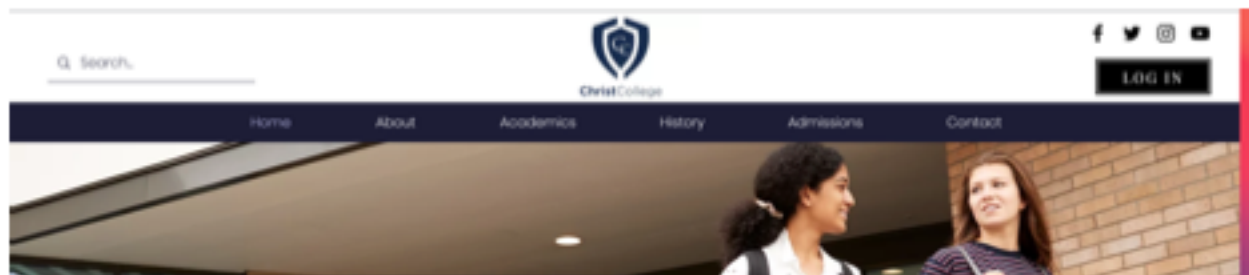


Christ College User Application and Enrollment

Step 1:

Goto christcollege.us and click the "Login" button on the top right corner of the home page.



Step 2:

Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the "Create New Account". On that page walk through the application and fill in all answers. (COMPLETE APPLICATION, your application can not be excepted or reviewed without a complete application)
